Our Crane Training Schools include training and instruction for various mobile cranes. Course subject comprises Wire Rope, Crane Set-up, Lift Planning, Load Dynamics, Signaling, Load Charts and Rigging.

The program is most suitable for crane riggers, operators as well as their supervisors. The materials incorporated in the course would consist of a manual and several informative handouts. The safety guidebook which is illustrated consists of 100 to 250 pages, depending on the course, of vital and useful material. Course materials include load charts and load chart exercises for the crane with which the person training is working.

Hands-On Safety Training would take up more than half of the course curriculum. The practical training part is the most effective method to improving and developing personal skill levels. Just qualified journeyman crane instructors are selected to teach the courses. Our instructors have many years of experience in the industry.

Optional testing mechanisms are offered for all of our courses. Students will normally write tests both prior to and following training. A test for skills is usually administered for programs that include H.O.S.T. Trainees will be graded and tested.

We provide certified training programs for the following cranes: Lattice Boom/Crawler Cranes; Fixed and Swing Cab Mobile Hydraulic Cranes; Rigging / Signalperson Training and Certification; Articulated Boom / Knuckleboom Cranes; Testing & Certification; and In-The-Seat Training.
