Introduction

Hence, businesses place a top priority on warehouse safety.

General Hazards

The most common workplace dangers include trips, falls and slips. Accidents similar to these happen as a result of the employee losing their balance and stumbling over something which has not been correctly put away. Placing or removing things from storage can lead to a slip or fumble, potentially leading to both worker and item to fall. The potential for trips, falls and slips is increased when workers are moving materials on different kinds of floor surfaces and on various levels. Another common danger is getting hit by falling things. This is normally caused by failure to properly stack items on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting techniques are another common hazard.

Warehouse equipment carries inherent dangers. Injuries or accidents can be caused by forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks if they are not operated correctly. Warehouse tools, such as skids, pallets, cutting and strapping tools, should be utilized cautiously during packing, unpacking and loading.

Hazardous substances, combustible or flammable materials could pose hazards while being stored in a warehouse. Staff should know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards while working around hazardous materials.
