The placement of trailer tires and chock blocks will be included in the lessons, as well as lessons on the arrangement of pallets to distribute the load right, and checks needed prior to driving into a trailer at a dock site. MSDS or Material Safety Data Sheet training is also covered in the course. Although not related directly to the use of a forklift, MSDS training is essential if an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on people and correct methods of handling spills.
